Please see attached the draw for the TTT Navigational Ride on Sunday, 9 August 2009 at Bullengarook Recreation Reserve.

We have received a record number of entries, far more than we ever anticipated. Accordingly, to ensure that the event runs smoothly could all teams please note the following:

1. Parking will be at a premium. It would be appreciated if riders could car pool where possible and also be prepared to park in the areas designated by our car parking attendants.
2. If you intend on arriving on the Saturday and camping for the night you need to book your space and also a yard if you require one with Lyn Grech on 03 5428 8338. There are limited yards available. There are no powered sites available. There is only one shower available and this cannot be used until the Sunday morning. Portable toilets will be near the camping area.
3. Entry to the grounds on the **Saturday** will not be available for entry until **after 4.00pm**. Entry will be through the back gate on the **Saturday (only)** with signs on the main road from either direction showing you the back way in.
4. All portable yards must be dismantled by 7.00am on the Sunday morning.
5. Entry to the grounds on the Sunday will be via the front entrance to the reserve.
6. The card secretary office will be open from 4pm – 6pm on the Saturday afternoon and from 7am onwards on the Sunday.
7. This is a rubbish free event and all riders should ensure that they take home all rubbish, manure and hay with them.
8. Please ensure that you present to gear check at least 20 minutes before your allocated riding time and also present to the start at your allocated riding time.
9. Please ensure that you present your current green Membership Card and Navigational Ride Card to the Secretary's office before you ride. To avoid having to ride HC or not at all, **please check that your membership card has been stamped for 2008/09 and your Nav Ride level assessment details have been written in on your performance card.**
10. Medical Armbands **MUST** be worn and please also ensure that you have a bridle/saddle cloth number on each side of your horse.

11. Use of GPS or SAT NAV equipment will not be allowed on the ride. Any competitors found to be using such equipment will do so under penalty of **ELIMINATION**.
12. Riders should be aware of motor bikes and other traffic whilst out on the ride.

With the record number of entries, it will be a long day and it would be appreciated if competitors could be patient whilst waiting for section and team results and we will do our best to get them finalised as early as possible.
